



Attendance was so strong and interest was so high that the <u>Forum</u> agreed to host a follow-up event, a Summit, if you will, to discuss the eastside's efforts regarding permanent affordable housing, homeless shelthers, and rapid re-housing. Clearly, interest in solving the eastside's housing crisis is strong - about 70 people gathered on a sunny August morning to discuss questions like: *Why is affordable housing an important issue for East King County?
